

LEIC Native Plant Sale ORDER FORM

The Lake Erie Islands Conservancy (LEIC) will soon be taking orders for native plants for the islands. We are using Natives in Harmony and Riverside Native Perennials for our native plant sale. Buying and planting natives is a great way to provide quality habitat for the birds, butterflies, moths and other wildlife on the islands. We are promoting the planting of natives because our wildlife are adapted to feeding on these plants and using them for shelter. This fundraiser will be used to support the LEIC land preservation and restoration programs!

Trees: OUR NATIVE TREE SALE IS MOVING TO THE FALL THIS YEAR! Be sure to watch for details coming out in our summer newsletter!

Plants: LEIC is selling varieties of native perennial plants and flowers as plugs (2.5" containers) from Natives in Harmony from Marengo, Ohio. You can use the order form provided for the list of native plant plugs. You can order ahead to make sure you get what you want, or we will have a selection for sale locally at our events this spring. Orders for Natives in Harmony plants may be placed until May 12th and we will arrange a pickup/delivery on the island in early May. For those on Middle Bass who wish to order, a pickup on Middle Bass will be set up as well. New this year are native perennials in larger container sizes through Riverside Native Perennials. You can order these by using this website <https://riversidenativeperennials.com/> and using the code LEIC to assure the Conservancy gets credit for the sale. Over the course of the spring they will be adding an additional 100 species of native perennials so please check in from time to time to see what additional plants have come online. They have assured us that the LEIC code will work through 2023, so you can support the Conservancy all year long with your native plant purchases!

Evening Primrose (<i>Oenothera biennis</i>) - sun, somewhat moist, prairies or thickets to lakeshore dunes, mid-summer to fall, honeybees, hummingbirds		Canada Wild Rye Grass (<i>Elymus canadensis</i>) - full sun, prairie, any type of dry to moist soil, draws butterflies, pollinators	
Bottlebrush Grass (<i>Hystrix patula</i>) - shade, woodland, tolerant of moist soil		Big Bluestem Grass (<i>Andropogon gerardii</i>) - Sandy to loamy soils, full sun or partial shade	
Fox Sedge (<i>Carex vulpinoidea</i>) - full sun, sand to clay, moist to wet soil, clumping, late spring to early summer		Virginia Wild Rye Grass (<i>Elymus virginicus</i>) - tolerant of shade, moist soil
